

Accreditation Visit of Food Science & Technology at Jinnah University for Women, Karachi

Jinnah University for women (JUW) started its journey in 1985 as Post Graduate College for girls. Later on, in 1998 the college was granted as Jinnah University for Women under the umbrella of Anjuman-e-Islamia Trust founded by Al-Haj Moulvi Reyazuddin Ahmed (T.I). The university was established with the vision “To educate mother, to educate the nation”. The university comprises of 05 faculties and 34 departments including Department of Food Science and Technology. The university has 252 regular teaching faculty with 30 Ph.Ds.

Prof. Dr. Naeem Farooqui, Vice Chancellor, JUW, Karachi presented a brief overview of university. Prof. Dr. Ishtiaq A. Rajwana, Chairperson, NAEAC shared the previous AICs visit recommendations of the departments beside a brief account on importance and significance of accreditation.

Afterward, AIC visited the Food Science & Technology department where detailed presentation and discussions were held. Ms. Anum Liaquat, Chairman, Department of Food Science and Technology briefed respective AIC in detail about working of the department and achievements in terms of student graduation, faculty positions and research projects. AIC also visited respective departmental infrastructure and held individual meetings with faculty members and students of the departments to get an insight of teaching/working environment in the department.

In the concluding session of the visit, the program evaluator shared their observations with the Prof. Dr. Naeem Farooqui, Vice Chancellor and other officials. Vice Chancellor, JUW thanked NAEAC team for their deliberations and inspection visit and assured that the recommendations made by AIC would be implemented to raise the standard of education and to improve the skills of the graduates.
