

Accreditation visit of Agronomy and Entomology degree programs at KFUEIT-Rahim Yar Khan

The establishment of the Khwaja Fareed University of Engineering & Information Technology (KFUEIT), Rahim Yar Khan in 2014 is a blessing for Southern Punjab, Northern Sindh and North Eastern Balochistan. It is named after the famous Sufi poet Khwaja Ghulam Fareed. KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan started its journey with merely 4 rooms, 5 faculty members and admission intake in 4 degree programs. Now a beautiful and state of the art campus is spread over 275 acres. The campus is equipped with all modern facilities where more than 600 employees including 200 teaching faculty members performing their duties in making this university a premium institution of the country in days to come.

Two Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs) comprising of Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC as a convener, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Aown Sammar Raza, Chairman, Department of Agronomy, The Islamia University of Bahawalpur (IUB) and Prof. Dr. Muhammad Anjum Aqueel, Chairman, Department of Entomology, IUB conducted accreditation visit of Agronomy and Entomology degree programs of KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan. On February 5, 2025, Dr. Adnan Noor Shah, Assistant Professor Agronomy & Coordinator Agriculture Sciences Program, Dr. Habib Ali Assistant Professor Entomology and Dr. Muhammad Saqlain Zaheer Lecturer Agronomy received the AIC team at KFC Canal Road, Rahim Yar Khan and escorted to university guest house.

The inaugural session was chaired by Prof. Ir. Dr. Amir Azam Khan, Vice Chancellor, KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan held in his office on February 6, 2025. Eng. Dr. Javed Iqbal, Registrar KFUEIT, Rahim Yar Khan, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Sagir, Dean of all Faculties, Dr. Muhammad Bilal Tahir, Director QEC, Dr. Yasir Niaz, HoD Agricultural Engineering, Dr. Adnan Noor Shah, Coordinator, Agriculture Sciences and other faculty members of the departments were present. Dr. Yasir Niaz, HoD Department of Agricultural Engineering started the session with the recitation of Holy Quran and presented the salient achievements of the university. Dr. Abdul Ghaffar Secretary NAEAC verbally explained the process of accreditation and previous ratings of the degree programs.

Afterwards, AICs visited the related departments where detailed presentations and discussions were held. HoDs of each department briefed the AIC regarding the working and achievements in terms of student's graduation, faculty positions and research projects. AICs visited the departmental labs, classrooms, library, glasshouse, faculty offices, flex installed in Agronomy field and held individual meetings with individual faculty members to know the level of satisfaction. Subject experts also held meetings with students to get an insight teaching environment in the departments.

In the exit meeting, program evaluators/experts shared their observations with the Vice Chancellor and other officials. Prof. Ir. Dr. Amir Azam Khan, Vice Chancellor thanked NAEAC team for their day long deliberation and assured that the recommendations made by the AICs would be implemented to raise the standard of education and to improve the skills of the graduates. In the end, the VC presented the souvenirs to the guests.
