

Accreditation visit of Food Science & Technology degree Program at The University of Lahore

The University of Lahore (UOL) is the largest private sector university in Pakistan with more than 35,000 students. It was established in 1999 and since then it is offering courses in the fields of Medicine & Dentistry, Engineering, Arts, Sciences and Social Sciences. With strong emphasis on balanced progress and focus on human capital, the university has grown to 11 faculties and more than 45 departments.



An Accreditation Inspection Committee (AIC) comprising of Prof. Dr. Imran Pasha, Dean, Faculty of Food, Nutrition & Home Sciences, University of Agriculture, Faisalabad (UAF) conducted accreditation visit of Food Science & Technology. Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ashraf chaired the inaugural session & presented overview and accomplishment of university, Prof. Dr. Ashfaq Ahmad, Dean presented an overview of the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences.



Then AIC moved to FST institute where detailed presentation of the institute accomplishment as per itinerary given by the HoD. AIC visited infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library, faculty offices, baking hall, food processing hall, support facilities and held meeting with students of the department to get an insight of teaching/working environment in these disciplines. In the noon, two major activities (curriculum review and individual faculty meeting) were carried out. Each course file was checked for its contents like lecture breakdown, assignments and examination results. AIC held individual faculty meeting to know the working environment, job satisfaction level and student teacher interaction.

Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ashraf, Rector, UOL chaired the concluding session where program evaluators/expert shared his observations. Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ashraf thanked AIC team for their day-long deliberations and inspection visit and assured that the recommendations made by AIC would be implemented to increase the standard of education.
