

Accreditation visit of Nutrition & Food Technology and Environmental Sciences degree Programs at University of Sindh- Jamshoro

University of Sindh was constituted under the University of Sindh Act. No. XVII of 1947 passed by the Legislative Assembly of Sindh. The development of the present Campus at Jamshoro, about 15 kilometer from Hyderabad on the right bank of River Indus now designated as Allama Imdad Ali Imam (AII), Kazi Campus, was started in late fifties. There are presently 4 Law Colleges and 74 Degree and Post Graduate Colleges (including 16 Private Colleges) affiliated to the university. The university comprises of 04 campuses and 09 faculties.

Two Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs) comprising of Prof. Dr. Fayyaz-ul-Hassan Sahi, Chairperson NAEAC as a convener, Prof. Dr. Inayatullah Rajapar, Dean, Faculty of Crop Production, Sindh Agriculture University (SAU), Tandojam, Prof. Dr. Aijaz Hussain Soomro, Director, Institute of Food Science & Technology, SAU, Tandojam as members conducted Accreditation visit of Environmental Sciences and Nutrition & Food Technology.

Prof. Dr. Naseem Aslam Channa, Director, Institute of Biotechnology, University of Sindh, Jamshoro and Dr. Amanullah Mahar, Director, Center for Environmental Sciences, University of Sindh, Jamshoro and other faculty members of respective departments received and welcomed NAEAC and AIC teams.

After receiving guests, AICs moved directly to relevant departments where detailed presentations of departmental accomplishments as per itinerary were given by the HoDs of respective departments. AICs visited departmental infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library, faculty offices, experimental research area, support facilities and held meeting with students of the department to get an insight of teaching/working environment in these disciplines. After the lunch, two major activities (curriculum review and individual faculty meeting) were carried out. Each course file was checked for its contents like lecture breakdown, assignments and examination results. AICs held individual faculty meeting to know the working environment, job satisfaction level and student teacher interaction.

In the concluding session of the visit, program evaluators/experts shared their observations with VC, Registrar, Director QEC and other HoD/officials/faculty members. Prof. (Meritorious), Dr. Muhammad Siddique Kalhoro, Vice Chancellor, University of Sindh, Jamshoro thanked NAEAC team for their day-long deliberations and inspection visit and assured that the recommendations made by AIC would be implemented to increase the standard of education and to expand the skills of the graduates.
