

## Pre-Accreditation/ Zero Visit of Human Nutrition & Dietetics Degree Program at Superior College of Commerce- Mandi Bahauddin

January 16, 2025

Superior college of commerce situated on Sargodha Road, Mandi Bahauddin, was formally inaugurated on December 6, 2021. The campus is spread over area of 16 Kanals. The campus is offering 26 degree programs including 23 BS, and 3 ADP programs with total 55 faculty members including 3 PhD faculty. Currently, there are 1500 students enrolled including 131 students in HND program. This college is affiliated with GCUF. The College have more than 50 class rooms including 4 class rooms for HND program having capacity of 50 students in each class. There are 15 labs including 3 labs for HND degree program.

Prof. Kashif Sheikh, Principal, Superior College of Commerce, Mandi Bahauddin (SCCM), Mr. Hafiz Ahsan, Vice Principal, SCCM and Mr. M. Hashaam Yasir, Focal person, SCCM received the guests on January 15, 2025. On January 16, 2025, Mr. Kashif Sheikh, Principal picked the AIC members from the Crystal Hotel. Dr. Taila Arif, HoD, Department of Human Nutrition & Dietetics and other faculty members received and welcomed NAEAC team members. Mr. Kashif Sheikh, Principal, SCCM chaired the inaugural session where Vice Principal, representative of QEC and concerned faculty members were also present. The inaugural session was held in the auditorium hall. This session began with the recitation of Holy Quran, followed by the condolence for Prof. Dr. Fayyaz ul Hassan, Chairperson NAEAC who passed away two days earlier. Principal of Campus prayed for the departed soul. He introduced the campus activities and accomplishments. Later, Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC shared the process and significance of accreditation.



Then Dr. Taila Arif, HoD, Department of HND presented the departmental achievements as per itinerary and explained some concerns as those standards and procedures are universities and not for affiliated colleges. During presentation, Prof. Usman Ali, Dean joined this session and presented his role to polish the students in communication skills. He also briefed about his plays (The Guilt and The Last Metaphor) included in the syllabus of M.Phil English literature. Later, AIC visited departmental infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library, faculty offices and held meeting with students of the department to get an insight of teaching environment in the department. Two major activities (curriculum review and meeting with individual faculty) were carried out in the afternoon after Zohar prayer. Each course file was checked for its contents like lecture breakdown, attendance, assignments and results. AIC held individual faculty meeting to know the working environment and job satisfaction level.

In the concluding session of the visit, the program evaluator/expert shared his observations with Principal of Campus, HoD and other faculty members. AIC members appreciated the hospitality and facilitation to conduct this zero visit. Principal of Campus thanked NAEAC team for their day-long deliberations and inspection visit and assured that the recommendations made by AIC would be implemented in true letter and spirit.
