Accreditation Visit of Forestry Degree Program at University of Swat (UoS)

University of Swat, a public sector university was established in 2010. The main campus of the university is situated in Charbagh, 13 km away from the main city Mingora, Swat District, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa,

Pakistan. This university was established for providing higher education to the people of Swat Valley specifically and the entire province generally. University of Swat has 02 subcampuses, Shangla and Women Campus, 6 faculties, 35 degree programs including forestry, 415 academic staff and more than 95,000 students.

An Accreditation Inspection Committee (AIC) comprising of Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC as a convener and Dr. Aamina Salim Chairman Forestry department AAUR as member conducted accreditation visit of Forestry degree program at UoS.

Dr. Bilal Ahmad and Dr. Naveed Alam Assistant Professor/ HoD of forestry department received the guests from Motorway Express Terminal. Both Drs accompanied us tell the University Director Admin picked the delegates at about 7:30PM. Mr. Imtiaz Ali, Registrar greeted the NAEAC team. Registrar





presented the salient accomplishments of the university with mission and vision. The inaugural session was held in the committee room of VC office. Mr. Imtiaz Ali chaired the session. The Director QEC, Dr. Muhammad Tariq, Controller of Examination, Dr. Arshad Ali Khan and Deans and Chairman attended this session. Dr. Muhammad Tariq, Director QEC acted as stage secretary presented university overview.

Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC presented a brief overview of NAEAC activities and explained how the accreditation process is completed. At the end of inaugural session souvenir were presented to both delegates.

Later AIC moved to forestry department where detailed presentation and discussions were held. Dr. Naveed Alam, HoD of forestry department briefed the AIC in detail about the department working and achievements in terms of student's graduation, faculty positions and research projects. AIC also visited departmental labs, classrooms, library, faculty offices, experimental research area and held individual meeting with faculty members to know the level of satisfaction and students of the department to get an insight pertaining to teaching environment in the department.

In the exit meeting, committee members shared their remarks with the Registrar and other officials. ? thanked NAEAC team for their day-long discussions and inspection visit.
