

Zero/Pre-Accreditation Visit of Forestry Degree Program- MUST- Pallandri Campus

The Mirpur University of Science and Technology (MUST), Mirpur was established in 2009 by up-grading Mirpur Campus of the University of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (UJK), Muzaffarabad. MUST-Pallandri Campus was established in 2018 and currently offering five degree programs including Forestry. Since then four batches of 36 students passed out while currently 6 students are enrolled in 2022-2026 batch.

An Accreditation Inspection Committees (AIC) comprising of Dr. Aamir Saleem, Chairman, Department of Forestry & Range Management, PMAS, Arid Agriculture University, Rawalpindi conducted Zero/Pre-accreditation of Forestry degree program at MUST- Pallandri Campus and Mr. Malik Arshad, Deputy Director Admin & Finance, NAEAC, Mr. Muhammad Shafqat NAEAC also accompanied the AIC team as facilitator.

Dr. Munawar Hussain Qureshi, Coordinator MUST-Pallandri, Dr. Rashida Hussain, Dean, Faculty of Natural & Applied Sciences, Dr. Nimra Maqsood, HoD, Department of Forestry and other faculty members received and welcomed AIC team.

The inaugural session was held in coordinator MUST- Pallandri Campus office where Dr. Munawar Hussain Qureshi chaired the session and briefed in detail about the accomplishment of the Pallandri campus. During inaugural session, Dean, Faculty of Natural & Applied Sciences, MUST, HoD of forestry department and other faculty members were present.

Then AIC moved to department where detailed presentations of departmental achievement as per itinerary were given by respective HoD. The AIC visited campus infrastructure including labs, classrooms, faculty offices, admission office, library, and medical facilities. AIC held meeting with students of the department to get an insight of teaching/working environment. In the afternoon, two major activities (curriculum review and individual faculty meeting) were carried out. Each course file was checked for its contents like lecture breakdown, assignments and examination results. AIC held individual faculty meeting to know about the working environment, job satisfaction level and student teacher interaction.
