

## Pre-Accreditation/Zero visit of Human Nutrition & Dietetics (HND) degree Program at University of Management & Technology- Lahore

University of Management & Technology (UMT), Lahore was founded as Institute of Leadership and Management (ILM) in 1990. There are 02 campus in Lahore and Sialkot, having more than 300+ PhD faculty members, offering more than 150 disciplines including HND. Currently more than 25000 students are enrolled.

Dr. Asif Raza, Rector, UMT, Lahore, Dr. Nauman Khalid, Dean, School of Food & Agricultural Sciences (SFAS), UMT, Lahore, Dr. Komal Javed, Chairperson, Department of HND, UMT, Lahore welcomed AIC team members. The AIC team meet the Dr. Asif Raza, Rector, UMT, Lahore in his office who briefed the team members about UMT. Dr. Nauman Khalid, Dean, SFAS presented a detail overview of UMT, the inaugural session was attended by Dr. Asif Saeed Haider, Director-Accreditations and Academic Quality Improvement Cell, Dr. Shahid Hassan, Controller Examinations Chairman Student Disciplinary Committee (SDC) and faculty of HND. The departmental presentation was presented by Dr. Komal Javed, HoD, HND. Later, Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC shared the accreditation rubrics (8) and sub-criteria (73) besides the importance and significance of accreditation.
