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## 1<sup>st</sup> Region-wise Training Workshop for NAEAC Program Evaluators at The University of Agriculture- Peshawar

**November 2, 2023**

NAEAC was established in 2005 with the mission to improve the standard and quality of agriculture and allied education based on established policies, procedures and criteria prescribed by HEC to meet emerging challenges of knowledge economy. One of the function of the council is to develop and update the roster of program evaluators/subject experts. Since 2007-08, council has been maintaining the roster that consists of experts of more than 16 disciplines of Agriculture.



Four training workshops were conducted in 2011, 2012, 2015 and 2017 in which about 120 evaluators participated. The new Chairman, Prof. Dr. Fayyaz-ul-Hassan took an initiative to expand the program evaluators pool in each discipline of Agriculture and Allied Sciences. The public/private sector universities and research departments were requested to nominate senior teachers/researchers for participation in accreditation process as and when required. Consequently, NAEAC received more than 400 nominations across the country. It was difficult to accommodate/manage one training workshop at Islamabad. Hence it was decided that region wise training workshop may be arranged. In this regard, first region-wise workshop was arranged at The University of Agriculture, Peshawar on November 2, 2023. Four training modules were prepared as follows:

- Quality assurance and accreditation process of NAEAC.
- Program evaluation criteria/standards/sub-criteria (Tool kit).
- Introduction of Agriculture Accreditation Automation System (AAAS).
- Roles and responsibilities of Program Evaluators, SWOT analysis and AIC report writing.

Fifty four new program evaluators representing different disciplines of Agriculture and Allied Sciences from UAP, AWKU Mardan, BKU Charsadda and PFI, Peshawar participated in the training workshop.

The training workshop was inaugurated by Prof. Dr. Ahamd-Ur-Rahman Saljoqi, Dean, Faculty of Crop Protection Sciences, The University of Agriculture, Peshawar (UAP) and concluding session was graced by the Prof. Dr. Jehan Bakht, Vice Chancellor, UAP. The Vice Chancellor appreciated this initiative and emphasized



that this type of training will not only facilitate the NAEAC but also add in quality education in the respective institutions. Accreditation certificates were distributed among HoDs/Chairman Department of Agricultural Biotechnology, Agricultural Chemistry, Entomology, Horticulture and Plant Pathology accredited during the last fiscal year. At the end the participants were served a modest lunch sponsored by NAEAC.



## 2<sup>nd</sup> Region-wise Training Workshop for NAEAC Program Evaluators at PMAS- Arid Agriculture University- Rawalpindi.

## Pre-Accreditation/Zero visit of Dietetics and Nutritional Science degree Program at University of Sialkot

University of Sialkot (USKT) was established in 2018. It is the first provincial chartered private sector university in Sialkot region with the vision that aspires academic excellence and quality research by developing culture of creativity and innovation with focus on social and cultural values. It has produced more than 5000 graduates including 300 graduates in Dietetics and Nutritional Science (DNS) who are serving in the various public and private sector Dietetics and Nutritional related organizations in and outside the country. The annual intake in the institute has been kept at a level of 50-75 students to ensure quality of education, training and research. The infrastructure of the university is well-established and enforced with well-equipped laboratories, up-to-date library and well-trained qualified academic staff.

Mr. Muhammad Yaqoob, Registrar USKT briefed the AIC team about the mission, objectives, structure and salient achievements of USKT in research, short trainings and education. Later, Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC through a presentation shared the accreditation standards and sub criteria besides the importance and significance of accreditation.

Dr. Rahamt Gul, Assistant Professor, DNS delivered a detailed presentation on the important features of education system at University of Sialkot. After the presentation, student interaction was held to know the regularity of teaching staff and conduction of practicals. Students were also inquired about hospitals visited within last month. AIC visited DNS infrastructure including labs, classrooms, library, faculty offices, hostels, sports facilities and examination hall. After the lunch and prayer the AIC committee held interaction with individual regular faculty members to get an insight of teaching/working environment in the departments. A review of the curriculum was also carried out. The committee inspected the lecture schedules, examination schedules, results and other teaching related documentation.

Later the guest speaker Dr. Abdul Ghaffar, Secretary NAEAC delivered his talk on "Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education". The main objective of this talk was to explain the overall process of accreditation and its significance in maintaining the quality of education. He emphasized that agriculture and Food Science share a common entry point "food" and food is a key outcome of agriculture activities. 

