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# **Manual (Toolkit)**

## July 24-25, 2022

NAEAC mandated to accredit agriculture and allied degree programs as per Bye-Laws and Procedures developed by Higher Education Commission, Islamabad. During the NAEAC 18th Council Board meeting, the Chairperson NAEAC was authorized to constitute the Toolkit Review Committee to revise the current Toolkit on top priority. The current toolkit was prepared in 2016-17, hence its revision was inevitable. Consequently, the Chairperson NAEAC constituted the committee comprising of:

First Toolkit Review Committee meeting was held at NAEAC Secretariat Office, Islamabad on July 24-25, 2022. The meeting was started with the recitation of Holy Quran. Prof. Dr. Ishtiag A. The proposed draft report will be submitted in the forthcoming Council Board meeting for final approval before replacing the earlier version of Toolkit.

## September 5-6, 2022

Shaheed Benazir Bhutto University (SBBU) is a public sector university established in 2009. The university is located in Sheringal at a distance of 35 km on the right of Dir city in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. It has a rich array of academic programs and research facilities to offer. There are 5 faculties and 22 departments with a strength of almost 4000 students and above 100 faculty members. Department of Forestry and Food Science & Technology (FST) was established in 2009 and 2016 respectively. Currently 117 students are enrolled in Forestry and 112 in FST.

Ziauddin Medical University was given the Charter as Ziauddin University vide 'The Ziauddin University' (Amendment ACT 2003) on December 13, 2005.

In the concluding session of the visit the program evaluators shared their observations with the Vice Chancellor and other officials including HoD's, Deans, Director ORIC and QEC. Prof. Dr. Jehan Bakht thanked NAEAC team for their two-day long deliberations and inspection visit. He gave his word that the suggestions provided by the AICs would be carried out in order to raise the bar of education and increase the market worth of the graduates produced.
