With the advent of Kotri barrage in 1955, the Government of Sindh under a comprehensive plan shifted the college to Tando Jam with added facilities of land, buildings and staff which was later evolved as Agriculture University in 1977. Currently, there are 05 faculties, 01 campuses, 02 colleges, 02 institutes and more than 30 departments. Currently enrolled students are 8500 and 275 faculty members.

Sindh University Engineering College was established in 1963 as a constituent college of University of Sindh in Jamshoro about 15 km from Hyderabad on the right bank of river Indus. The college was first declared as an additional campus of the University of Sindh headed by a Pro-Vice-Chancellor in July 1976 and later upgraded to the level of independent University on 1st March, 1977 through an ordinance issued by the Government of Sindh. The or-



dinance was later converted into an Act of the Provincial Assembly of Sindh Province. Initially, the Additional Campus as well the Mehran University was established in the City of Nawabshah. However, in 1979, the Act of the University was amended and the seat of the University was retained at Jamshoro, while a constituent college was maintained at Nawabshah which has also become an independent university in 1996. The number of students admitted to the First Year classes of all the disciplines under regular scheme at Jamshoro is 1053 out of which 1000



candidates are admitted from Sindh Province, including Karachi Division, according to a precisely calculated ratio of population and other considerations. Thirty four applicants are admitted from other parts of Pakistan while 19 seats are reserved for the foreigners. Whereas under Self Finance Scheme and Special Scheme 548 and 86 candidates are admitted from Sindh province respectively.

The University of Karachi was established by an act of parliament in June, 1951. The present campus, to which the University shifted in 1959, is spread over 1279 acres of land. There are over 52 departments and 19 research institutes/ centers, which are imparting education to more than 24,000 students including students from foreign countries. Ziauddin University is HEC recognized degree awarding institution which was founded in the memory of Sir Dr. Ziauddin Ahmad, a renowned academician, philosopher, mathematician and political figure. His vision was to spread quality education amongst the Muslims of the subcontinent. The first step towards the development of an academic arm of the Ziauddin Group was taken in 1986 when the School of Nursing was established and recognized by Pakistan Nursing Council. The school was transformed into the College of Nursing in 2009 and is offering various programs for graduate and undergraduate students since then. In August 1994, the Government of Sindh granted permission for the establishment of the Dr. Ziauddin Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences. By the virtue of this ordinance, the institute could grant its own Postgraduate degrees and diplomas.
