NAEAC Accreditation Inspection Committees visits to four Agriculture Education Institutions in Punjab, Sindh and KPK.

External evaluation and accreditation is the single most important function of the Council mandated by the Higher Education Commission. During the last few weeks, the Council organized four on-site visits of the experts/program evaluators of the Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs). The on-site visit of the AICs to the degree programs of Agronomy, Soil Science, and Entomology was carried out at BZU Bahadar Sub-Campus, Layyah on March 19, 2014. While second on-site visit to five disciplines of Soil Science, Agronomy, Horticulture, Food Science and Entomology was carried out for one day on March 20, 2014 at University of Haripur. The external assessment and accreditation of four degree programs at Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Agriculture College (SZABAC), Dokri, Larkana (Agronomy, PBG, Soil Science, and Horticulture) was accomplished by four AICs on March 31, 2014. All the on-site AICs visits were carried out with the mutual consent of the concerned Dean, Principal and HoDs of the host institutions. The overall objective is to build the capacity of human and physical resources of degree programs to enable to improve, maintain and enhance the quality and standards of higher education in Pakistan. The Council hopes to achieve its annual target of accreditation of 40 degree programs successfully by the end of June, 2014.
