Quality Assurance and Accreditation Awareness Seminars organized by NAEAC

Organization and conduct of awareness seminars for the stakeholders is an integral part of the activities of the National Agriculture Education Accreditation Council (NAEAC). The objective of the activity is to create awareness among the stakeholders and sensitize them regarding the significance of accreditation of degree awarding programs. During 2014-15, at least five awareness seminars have been planned for the newly initiated agriculture degree programs in various institutions of KPK, Punjab, Sindh and Balochistan.
