

## Visit of Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs) of NAEAC/HEC to Faculty of Agricultural Sciences at Ghazi University, D. G. Khan

The Accreditation Inspection Committees (AICs) of HEC visited Faculty of Agricultural Sciences Ghazi University, D. G. Khan on 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2016. The main objective of the visit was to conduct a peer review of the degree programs of the departments of Entomology, Agronomy, PBG, Soil Science and Horticulture. The subject experts/program evaluators were senior professors of these subjects. The Dean of the faculty gave a brief presentation to the experts team in his office. Later on, experts had a long deliberations with the chairmen of the above mentioned departments. The HoDs along with faculty members gave detailed presentation on the faculty, curriculum, infrastructure, resources and facilities available with the department. They also pointed out major strengths and shortcomings of their degree programs. The review committee also received feedback from under-graduate and graduate students.

2. The AICs also visited infrastructure and learning resources including labs, library, class rooms and faculty offices etc. They also visited experimental farm used for graduate research activities.

3. The AICs also had meeting with the Registrar of the Ghazi University. All the experts shared their views and discussed highlights and findings of the visit with the Registrar. The AICs members urged the Dean to communicate main findings and conclusions of the visit to the worthy vice



chancellor. The wrap-up/exit meeting was also held with the Dean of the faculty, Registrar and other senior faculty members of the faculty of agricultural sciences.
